

Greetings

We hope your child (or children) has enjoyed their year in our programs. We would love to see them return in the fall!

For the 2018-2019 Scouting year, 72nd Ottawa will be running Beavers (age 5-7), Cubs (age 8-10), and Venturer (age 15-18) sections at St. Rita's. We will be restarting our Scouts section (age 11-14) collaborating with the 115th Parkwood Hills Troop on Mondays at City View United Church (6 Epworth Avenue). As we did not run a Scouts section this year, we expect our registration numbers for Scouts may be a bit low – this will give youth more opportunity with a larger combined group. We are also rebuilding our leader base, and hopefully we will have our Scouts section back at the 72nd the following year. If anyone is interesting in being a Scout leader, please contact me.

You can register in the fall, when **all** those back-to-school expenses come in, or you can save the hassle, and some money, but registering in May or June! Our registration fees are as follows:

- Register between **May 1** (returning members only)/**May 15** (new members) – **June 30** = **\$230**
- Register between **July 1** – **December 31** (all members) = **\$270**

So registering before July 1 gives you a \$40 savings! And registering in May covers new (and returning members) from time of registration until August 2019.

If you consider that most of our programs have about 30 meetings a year, that's less than \$10/ meeting, which is comparable for the per-lesson cost for swimming, piano, etc! It's a great deal. A large part of the registration fee goes to Scouts Canada, the remaining portion is for our group to pay for school rental, badges, leader training courses, and camp subsidies. Scouts Canada now uses ONLINE registrations. The process for registering is as follows:

- To get to the online system, go to www.scouts.ca
 - Hit the **Find A Group** button
 - Put in your postal code, and in the results look for **72nd Ottawa**, do a SEARCH, when the results come up, hit **DETAILS** link, and you can register from there

We will need to have more neckers made (as a side note, 1 necker costs somewhere between \$10-\$15 – please treat them with care!). We have elected not to cover all our costs through registration. We *expect* everyone will help with fundraising.
- Many parents have interesting jobs or specialized skills that leaders don't necessarily have. If you have any great ideas for a tour (ie we once had a tour of the international area at the airport, they locked our Cubs in one of the detention rooms!, we had a tour of the First Air facilities, we love going interesting places!) let us know and we will book it in for next year's programming. Same thing – if you know of any groups or speakers who would come and chat with Beavers or Cubs this helps us broaden our program.
